Finalists will be invited to take part in short interviews with the NTC Scholarship Review Committee. Please complete this application form in English.

Eligibility: Any Junior or Senior high school student of US citizenship residing in the Dallas-Fort Worth area, who has attained beginner to intermediate German language proficiency, may apply. Please note that native or heritage speakers of German are excluded from consideration. The NTC Memorial Scholarship may only be awarded once to any individual applicant.

Guidelines: All submissions should be text only and approximately 300 words in length. The essay must be double spaced with 1-inch margins and written in a 12-point Times New Roman font. Submissions far beyond or below this length will not be considered. All essays should be original submissions written without the aid of second parties or reliance on online translators. Dictionaries may be consulted for use with individual words. Any quotes, paraphrased material, or unoriginal ideas should be properly cited using endnotes or citations within the text. Essays will be judged on basis of originality, depth of subject matter discussion, correctness of German vocabulary and grammar, and general interest.
